Volunteer Types

Volunteer - Level A PLUS

Direct one-on-one supervision of students is permitted

While in contact with students, Level A PLUS volunteers must be under the oversight of a District employee.

Applies to: All non-contractual tutors, non-contractual mentors, chaperones for out of county field or athletic trips, chaperones for overnight field or athletic trips, field trip drivers, and athletic team drivers.

- Fingerprinted Volunteer Criminal Background Check through VECHS (Volunteer and Employee Criminal History System)
- Valid for 5 years
- Cost \$42.50

Volunteer - Level A

Direct one-on-one supervision of students is not permitted

While in contact with students, Level A volunteers must be within line of sight of a District employee.

Applies to: In-county field trip chaperones, in-county athletic team chaperones, volunteers supervising small groups of students.

- Non-fingerprinted Volunteer Criminal Background Check through Brevard County Sheriff's Office
- Valid for 3 years
- Cost \$20.00
